The Board in special session for which time, place and agenda being posted at 8:30 a.m. June 30, 2025 for July 1, 2025 with Milton Honeycutt, John Anderson and Kevin Grimes present; Cotton County Clerk Joseph Schappert, Cotton County Clerk Chief Deputy/BOCC Assistant Sandy Edgmon, Cotton County Sheriff Tim King, Cotton County Emergency Management Director Lori Hedges, Cotton County Court Clerk Terry Kelley, Cotton County Tax Assessor Virgina Brasier, OSU Extension Director Kim Davis, Excise Board Vice-Chairman David Edgmon and Walters/Cotton County E911 Trust Authority Chairman Joe Keaton were present for the meeting.

- The meeting was called to order by Chairman Honeycutt. A.
- В. Agreement with Valeria Horschler Living Trust, Doris Ann Sorenson-Trustee to work on private property located on the East Seventy (70) acres of the East Half (E/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Four (4) South, Range Ten (10) West, Indian Meridian, Cotton County, State of Oklahoma, for the purpose of cleaning and clearing trees and brush in fence row was presented and approved on motion by Anderson, 2nd by Honeycutt. Votes: Honeycutt-AYE, Anderson-AYE, Grimes-AYE.
- C. Agreement with Lendell Ellis Revocable Trust, Kristin Ellis Kilpatrick and Justin Scott Ellis, Co-Trustees to work on private property located on the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Four (4) South, Range Ten (10) West and the West 90 acres of the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Twenty (20), Township Four (4) South, Range Ten (10) West, Indian Meridian, Cotton County, State of Oklahoma, for the purpose of cleaning and clearing trees and brush in fence row was presented and approved on motion by Anderson, 2nd by Honeycutt. - D. County General Budget for fiscal year 2025-2026 was discussed. Clerk Schappert stated at this point an additional \$123,703.77 must be reduced from the current preliminary budget to meet the FYE26 requirement of \$1,831,955.61.Clerk Chief Deputy Edgmon payroll will be moved back to Highway affective August, 2025 for an estimated \$47,000 reduction with Edgmon reporting to County Clerk and BOCC. Treasurer Simpson committed to an additional reduction of \$2499.00. Assessor Brasier committed to reducing both Assessor and Visual Inspection budgets after performing an additional review of her needs. Sheriff King expressed concern of creating overtime by meeting such a significant drop in budget. He will review his needs in line with a 16% reduction and will provide his committed reduction amount. He will eet with Clerk Schappert and Commissioner Grimes who will assist in the Sheriff budget reduction exercise.

Clerk Schappert stated he will pay 1 deputy for 10 months out of RM&P fund for a \$42,183.70 reduction. Commissioner Grimes offered to meet with all officers individually to understand all budget needs and offer recommendations. All officers are requested to provide Clerk Schappert with any additional reductions they are able to commit to. The Board appointed Commissioner Grimes as the BOCC presentative at the Excise Board Budget Meeting on August 4, 2025 to provide any insight and answer any questions regarding budget needs of he various departments.
