## NOTICE OF RESALE OF REAL ESTATE FOR TAXES

## Oklahoma Fishing

### CENTRAL

**Arcadia:** May 18. Elevation is 0.5 ft. above normal and stable, water temperature 78°F and murky. (USACE Lake Level) Blue catfish fair on cut bait and stinkbait around channels and main lake. White bass fair on spinnerbaits and spoons around flats and points. Crappie fair on jigs and minnows around brush structure and docks. Report submitted by Dalton Buley, game warden stationed in Oklahoma County.

**Hefner:** May 18. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 78°F and murky. (USGS Lake Level) White bass fair on jigs and small lures around channels and points. Channel and flathead catfish fair on cut bait and dough bait around points and shorelines. Crappie fair on jigs and minnows around brush structure and shorelines. Report submitted by Dalton Buley, game warden stationed in Oklahoma County.

**Overholser:** May 18. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 75°F and stained. (USGS Lake Level) Crappie fair on hair jigs, jigs, and minnows around dam and docks. Blue and channel catfish good on cut bait and minnows around riprap, shallows, and shorelines. Striped bass hybrids and white bass fair on flukes and jigs around points, shorelines. Report submitted by Mark Murray, game warden stationed in Canadian County.

**Thunderbird:** May 13. Elevation is 4 ft. below normal and stable, water temperature 72°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) Crappie good on jigs and minnows around brush structure, docks, and shorelines. Largemouth bass good on crankbaits and spinnerbaits around coves, shorelines, and weed beds. Blue and channel catfish good on cut bait, minnows, and worms around points, shallows, and shorelines. Report submitted by Zach Hanson, game warden stationed in Cleveland County.

**Wes Watkins:** May 19. Elevation is 2 ft. below normal and falling, water temperature 75°F and stained. (USGS Lake Level) Channel catfish good on cut bait, punch bait, stinkbait, and worms around points, riprap, and shorelines. Largemouth bass fair on crankbaits, plastic baits, and spinnerbaits around brush structure and points. Report submitted by Mike France, game warden stationed in Pottawatomie County.

**Canton:** May 12. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 65°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) White bass slow on jigs, lipless baits around river mouth. Striped bass hybrids slow on live bait around main lake. Crappie slow on jigs and minnows around brush structure. Report submitted by Jaylen Flynn, game warden stationed in Blaine County.

**Fort Supply:** May 18. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 73°F and stained. (USACE Lake Level) Crappie fair on jigs and minnows around main lake, points, and rocks. Report submitted by Jason Badley, game warden stationed in Harper County.

**Foss:** May 17. Elevation is 1 ft. below normal and stable, water temperature 61°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth and smallmouth bass good on buzz baits, crankbaits, flukes, and plastic baits around brush structure, shallows, and standing timber. Walleye good on crawfish, flukes, and spoons around dam, main lake, and riprap. Crappie good on jigs, minnows, and tube jigs around channels, river channel, shorelines, and weed beds. Report submitted by Clint Carpenter, game warden stationed in Custer County.

### SOUTHEAST

**Arbuckle:** May 19. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 74°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth and smallmouth bass fair on Alabama rigs, jigs, and plastic baits around main lake and points. Crappie slow on minnows, small lures, and tube jigs around brush structure. Green sunfish good on crickets, small lures, and worms around coves. Report submitted by Casey young, game warden stationed in Murray County.

**Blue River:** May 19. Elevation is normal and rising, water temperature 74°F and clear. (USGS Lake Level) Largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass good on buzz baits, crankbaits, flukes, jerk baits, jigs, lipless baits, spinnerbaits, topwater lures, and tube jigs around brush structure, channels, creek channels, points, river channel, rocks, shallows, and shorelines. Channel catfish fair on chicken liver, punch bait, and worms around brush structure, channels, river channel, and rocks. Report submitted by Ethan Lovelace, biologist at the Blue River Public Fishing and Hunting Area.

**Broken Bow:** May 17. Elevation is 7 ft. below normal and falling, water temperature 74°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass fair on Alabama rigs, bill baits, crankbaits, flukes, in-line spinnerbaits, plastic baits, and spoons around brush structure, creek channels, main lake, points, and standing timber. Crappie good on hair jigs, jigs, and minnows around brush structure, points, and standing timber. Channel catfish good on dough bait, punch bait, and shrimp around channels and points. Report submitted by Dru Polk, game warden stationed in McCurtain County.

**Carl Albert:** May 16. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 74°F and stained. Largemouth bass fair on crankbaits, grasshoppers, grubs, jigs, minnows, plastic baits, spinnerbaits, and worms around brush structure, channels, main lake, shorelines, and weed beds. Blue and channel catfish fair on chicken liver, hot dogs, live bait, live shad, minnows, shad, stinkbait, sunfish, and worms around brush structure, channels, coves, main lake, shorelines, and weed beds. Crappie fair on grubs, hair jigs, jigs, minnows, plastic baits, small lures, and spinnerbaits around brush structure, creek channels, flats, main lake, shorelines, and weed beds. Report submitted by Blake Dull, game warden stationed in Latimer County.

**Carlton:** May 16. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 75°F and stained. Largemouth and smallmouth bass fair on crickets, grubs, jigs, minnows, plastic baits, and worms around brush structure, creek channels, main lake, rocks, shorelines, and weed beds. Blue, channel, and flathead catfish fair on chicken liver, cut bait, live shad, minnows, shad, and stinkbait around coves, main lake, shorelines, and weed beds. Crappie slow on minnows, plastic baits, small lures, and worms around brush structure, creek channels, rocks, shallows, shorelines, and weed beds. Report submitted by Blake Dull, game warden stationed in Latimer County.

**Eufaula:** May 15. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 70°F and stained. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass good on Alabama rigs, crankbaits, jerk baits, and plastic baits around creek channels, docks, points, and rocks. Blue, channel, and flathead catfish fair on cut bait, hot dogs, shad, and stinkbait below the dam, river channel, and river mouth. Crappie fair on hair jigs, minnows, and spoons around brush structure, creek channels, and docks. Report submitted by Corey Fel-

zien, game warden stationed in Muskogee County.

**Hugo:** May 15. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 74°F and murky. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth, spotted, and white bass fair on bill baits, crankbaits, jigs, plastic baits, and topwater lures around brush structure, coves, main lake, points, shorelines, and standing timber. Crappie slow on jigs, minnows, and small lures around brush structure, shorelines, and standing timber. Blue, channel, and flathead catfish fair on chicken liver, cut bait, and live bait around main lake, river channel, and spillway. Report submitted by Chance Phillips, game warden stationed in Choctaw County.

**Konawa:** May 17. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 74°F and clear. Largemouth bass good on crankbaits, lipless baits, and plastic baits around main lake, points, river channel, and weed beds. Striped bass hybrids and white bass good on Alabama rigs, crankbaits, and live shad around coves, discharge, main lake, and river channel. Channel catfish good on chicken liver, cut bait, and shrimp around coves, inlet, riprap, and weed beds. Report submitted by Garret Harley, game warden stationed in Seminole County.

**Lower Mountain Fork River:** May 17. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 59°F and clear. Brown and rainbow trout good on hair jigs, midges, nymphs, PowerBait, small lures, and worms around discharge, river channel, rocks, and spillway. Report submitted by Dru Polk, game warden stationed in McCurtain County.

**McGee Creek:** May 15. Elevation is 1 ft. below normal and stable, water temperature 67°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth and spotted bass excellent on bill baits, buzz baits, crankbaits, in-line spinnerbaits, jerk baits, jigs, minnows, plastic baits, and topwater lures around brush structure, docks, riprap, shallows, and shorelines. Channel and flathead catfish good on cut bait, dough bait, live bait, live shad, stinkbait, and worms around creek channels, dam, and riprap. Crappie fair on minnows, small lures, and tube jigs around brush structure, rocks, and standing timber. Report submitted by Shay Loudermilk, game warden stationed in Atoka County.

**Murray:** May 12. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 60°F and stained. Largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, and crappie fair on jigs, plastic baits, small lures, spoons, tube jigs, and worms around brush structure, dam, docks, shallows, and weed beds. Blue, channel, and flathead catfish slow on stinkbait and worms around creek channels, dam, main lake, and rocks. Report submitted by Royce Gillham, game warden stationed in Love County.

**Pine Creek:** May 15. Elevation is 1 ft. above normal and stable, water temperature 73°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass good on crankbaits, jigs, plastic baits, spinnerbaits, and topwater lures around brush structure, points, shorelines, and standing timber. Crappie fair on jigs, minnows, and small lures around brush structure and standing timber. Blue, channel, and flathead catfish good on chicken liver, live bait, and worms around channels, main lake, and shallows. Report submitted by Chance Phillips, game warden stationed in Choctaw County.

**Robert S. Kerr:** May 15. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 71°F and murky. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth, smallmouth, and spotted bass good on crankbaits, jerk baits, jigs, small lures, and topwater lures around brush structure, coves, docks, riprap, standing timber, and weed beds. Striped bass, striped bass hybrids, and white bass fair on hair jigs, jigs, live shad, minnows, spoons, and topwater lures below the dam, channels, riprap, rocks, and shorelines. Blue, channel, and flathead catfish good on chicken liver, cut bait, hot dogs, live bait, stinkbait, and sunfish below the dam, channels, creek channels, and river channel. Report submitted by James Pixley, game warden stationed in Haskell County.

**Sardis:** May 15. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 72°F and stained. (USACE Lake Level) Largemouth bass good on bill baits, buzz baits, crankbaits, lipless baits, plastic baits, and spinnerbaits around brush structure, coves, points, shorelines, and standing timber. Blue, channel, and flathead catfish fair on cut bait, shad, sunfish, and worms around brush structure, channels, main lake, points, and standing timber. Crappie fair on jigs, minnows, and tube jigs around brush structure and standing timber. Report submitted by Thomas Gillham, game warden stationed in Pushmataha County.

**Texoma:** May 17. Elevation is 3 ft. above normal and stable, water temperature 73°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) Striped bass fair on live shad around channels, points, and river channel. Blue, channel, and flathead catfish fair on cut bait, dough bait, live shad, and stinkbait below the dam, docks, and river channel. Crappie fair on caddis flies, hair jigs, and jigs around brush structure, coves, docks, and standing timber. Comments: Fishing this week has been okay. Striper has been okay this week. Some days are better than others. The big winds the last few days have made it tougher. Catfish are being caught on ledges and river channels on live bait and cut bait. Crappie are being caught on jigs around brush and in open water in 8-12 ft. of water. Report submitted by Garrett Beam, game warden stationed in Marshall County.

### SOUTHWEST

**Altus-Lugert:** May 17. Elevation is 22 ft. below normal and falling, water temperature 68°F and murky. (USACE Lake Level) Walleye slow on jigs and minnows around brush structure, docks, and rocks. Channel catfish fair on jigs, minnows, and worms around brush structure, coves, docks, and rocks. Comments: Fishing activity slowed possibly due to high winds. Report submitted by Brandon Lehman, game warden stationed in Greer County.

**Ellsworth:** May 17. Elevation is 7 ft. below normal and stable, water temperature 70°F and murky. (USGS Lake Level) White bass, crappie, and saugeye fair on hair jigs, jigs, minnows, sassy shad, and small lures around brush structure, docks, points, and shorelines. Blue and channel catfish fair on chicken liver, dough bait, punch bait, and shad around main lake and points. Report submitted by Mike Carroll, game warden stationed in Comanche County.

**Fort Cobb:** May 18. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 68°F and stained. (USACE Lake Level) Crappie slow on hair jigs and jigs around docks. Striped bass hybrids fair on jigs around points. Report submitted by Justin Cornett, game warden stationed in Caddo County.

**Lawtonka:** May 17. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 71°F and clear. (USACE Lake Level) White bass and saugeye fair on hair jigs, minnows, sassy shad, and small lures around points, rocks, and shorelines. Blue and channel catfish slow on cut bait, dough bait, punch bait, and shad around main lake and points. Report submitted by Mike Carroll, game warden stationed in Comanche County.

**Tom Steed:** May 18. Elevation is 4 ft. below normal and stable, water temperature 70°F and murky. (USACE Lake Level) Blue and channel catfish good on cut bait, stinkbait, and worms around rocks. Report submitted by David Smith, game warden stationed in Kiowa County.

**Waurika:** May 18. Elevation is normal and stable, water temperature 75°F and murky. Largemouth bass, striped bass hybrids, white bass, and crappie good on crankbaits, hair jigs, jigs, minnows, plastic baits, PowerBait, small lures, and worms below the dam, docks, main lake, and shorelines. Blue and channel catfish fair on chicken liver, hot dogs, shad, and stinkbait around main lake, rocks, and shorelines. Report submitted by Tucker Clem, game warden stationed in Jefferson County.
